PRESENTATIONS

You may choose your own subject or be assigned a topic to present to the class. If you choose your own subject, it must relate it directly to cell physiology and be approved by your instructor.

Textbook information, along with research from the literature or laboratory investigations should be used to prepare for your presentation. Handouts, overheads, PowerPoint presentations, or other visual aids may accompany what you present to the class. If you are a graduate student, you are required to provide a written report (250 word minimum, excluding references) that includes research from at least two refereed journal articles.

Student presentations may occur at any time during the lecture, as requested by students. However, they must take place on the day they are assigned by the instructor. Presentations are limited to ten (10) minutes in length, followed by no more than 5 minutes of discussion.

Your grade will be determined according to the PRESENTATION EVALUATION FORM handed out in class.
